As of October 1st 2005 the harmonised standard for warning devices (TS50131-4) had not been published. However, the interim Code of Practice, PD6662:2004, has been adopted by all interested parties in the UK and all of the Flashguard branded sounders listed in the table above comply with the performance requirements for warning devices detailed in Annex C of PD6662.
